Quinta do Relógio Palace - Oeiras -Lisbon - Portugal

Spectacular Quinta do Relógio Palace this 19th-century property was built in 1860, under the reign of His Royal Highness Dona Maria II, under the direction of architect Cinatti de Siena. It was the residence of His Royal Highness, El Rei D. Fernando II. In its gardens stands out the Clock Tower that gave the property its name. At this time the property belongs to the heirs of His Royal Highness el Rey D. João I and D. Filipa de Lencastre, Queen of Portugal. Neoclassical environment present in the sumptuousness of the ornamentation of buildings surrounded by an immense and dense vegetation, from which several species of trees stand out for their configuration and antiquity such as the Araucaria, the Plátanos and the Dracaenas. The outdoor space features different levels of terrain arranged around a courtyard where garages, stables and service quarters are located. Main building with ground floor, 1st floor and attic, porch, entrance hall, staircase illuminated by skylight, three rooms with sea view and direct access to the garden.
